

Big-hitter Paul blasts his way to Nevada

DARTMOUTH Golf and Country Club sponsored long drive professional Paul 'Hammer Time' Glazier has qualified for the 2007 RE/MAX World Long Drive Championships at Palms Golf Club in Mesquite, Nevada, next month.

The former Kingsbridge and South Devon cricket all-rounder, who has been a regular on the Long Drivers of Europe (LDE) European Long Drive tour this season, qualified for the flagship event courtesy of one of two automatic qualification spots in this year's LDE Order of Merit table.

With only the RE/MAX Long Drive Championships of Benelux to go in Amsterdam today, the big hitting Devonian is currently in second spot without any of his nearest rivals in a position to dislodge him.

"It was my goal at the beginning of the year, so to achieve it with one round still to go is a great achievement, particularly with the depth of talent on the tour," said Glazier.

In addition to facing some of the finest long-drivers on the planet in America, Glazier will also compete for a share of the \$550,000 prize fund, including the \$125,000 winner's cheque.
